OPEN TO THE PUBLIC:

No one came forward to speak.

MEMBERSHIP:

Lt. T. Dell'Anno commented that there were three new member applications from the following: Nathaniel Kinkaid, Robert Ritter, and Stephen Warne.

18.05.08.122 Commissioner Byrnes moved, and Commissioner Murphy seconded the motion to approve the membership applications of Nathaniel Kinkaid, Robert Ritter, and Stephen Warne. **APPROVED.**

Minutes:

18.05.08.123 Commissioner Miller moved, and Commissioner Murphy seconded the motion to approve the Board Meeting Minutes of April 10, 2018. **APPROVED.**

Purchasing Director's Report:

Bill Adams commented the sealed bids for the possible purchase of a motor home for rehab purposes was opened on May 7, 2018 and one bid was received from Albany RV with a bid of \$84,000.00 for a new 2017 Winnebago Fuse. A discussion followed on the permissive referendum end date, specifications, deposit and payment, and delivery:

- Permissive referendum period notifying residents of a possible expenditure of funds from the Apparatus Reserve Fund will end on May 13, 2018.
- Clarification that the price will include vinyl seats since there was no indication on the bid but was included in the specifications.
- \$1000 deposit needed to hold the vehicle with the consensus to take the money from the General Fund to be reimbursed from the Apparatus Reserve Fund.
- Get a date for delivery.

18.05.08.124 Commissioner Byrnes moved and Commissioner Murphy seconded the motion to approve the purchase of a 2017 Winnebago Fuse, contingent on the permissive referendum not being contested, at a cost of \$84,000 with funds to be expended from the Apparatus Reserve Fund with payment approved and check to be cut no sooner than May 13, 2018, and approval of \$1000 deposit check to be cut from the General Fund to be reimbursed from the Apparatus Reserve Fund after May 13, 2018. **APPROVED.**

- 18.05.08.129 Commissioner Miller moved, and Commissioner Byrnes seconded the motion to approve R. Craver's attendance at the EVOC course starting May 9, 2018. **APPROVED.**
- 18.05.08.130 Commissioner Miller moved, and Commissioner Byrnes seconded the motion to approve M. Dittmer's attendance at the FFI summer course held in Albany County starting May 29, 2018. **APPROVED.**

Purchasing Director's Report (cont.):

Discussion:

- Bill Adams commented that he did some research on possible sale of the MED units with the used value ranging from \$25-35K. A brief discussion followed.
- Bill commented on the recent boiler repairs with the replacement of the temperature sensor and evaporation valve. He further commented that due to the electronic controls, it is costlier to repair than in past years and the time span of boilers are shorter.
- Discussion on purchase of 8 sets of Globe turnout gear to include knee pads in the specs. Discussion followed with the consensus to approve the installation on knee pads on current gear during the annual inspection by Elliot Enterprises in July.
- Bill commented that we will need 60 new helmets by the end of 2019 and he would like to purchase 30 this year and 30 in 2019.
- Discussion of disposing of the old turnout gear that have exceeded the limit of service. Bill commented that there are approximately 9 sets of gear in this category.
- Request by Shen Key Club to hold a car wash at Station 2 on May 20, 2018. Bill commented he will chaperone.
- Renewal of annual service agreements for the MRx monitors and Tri Air sampling. Bill commented that the TRI
 Air bill needs to be approved so supplies can be ordered.
 Replacement of smoke detectors at Station 1 found to be defective during inspection by Mahoney Notifier during
 the semi-annual inspection. Commissioner Murphy inquired if they have smoke and CO detector combination
 detector and Bill said he would ask.
- Bill reported that the SC Sheriff's Dept requested the use of the Training Room May 22-24, 2018 for Taser training.
- 18.05.08.136 Commissioner Miller moved, and Commissioner Tobin seconded the motion to approve the purchase of 8 sets of Globe Turnout gear from Municipal Emergency Services (MES) on state contract at a cost not to exceed \$20,175.52. **APPROVED.**
- 18.05.08.137 Commissioner Miller moved, and Commissioner Tobin seconded the motion to approve the installation of knee pads in 30 pairs of existing turnout gear pants by Globe at a cost of \$1525.50 to be invoiced by Municipal Emergency Services. **APPROVED.**
- 18.05.08.138 Commissioner Miller moved, and Commissioner Tobin seconded the motion to approve the purchase of 30 helmets from MES at a cost of \$300/each for a total of \$9000.00. **APPROVED.**
